



Longleaze is a primary school of 262 children situated in the north Wiltshire town of Royal Wootton Bassett. The original building dates from 1973, and in the last 35 years it has been extensively remodelled to support the 21st century curriculum.

The school is presently organised into nine classes, all housed within the main building. The mobile classroom is used for small groups, music lessons and by Family Learning, the on-site Children's Centre, and the Out of School Club.

In the grounds we have an EYFS/KS1 playground and a KS2 playground, a quiet area, a conservation area and pond, and the Site Manager's bungalow. We enjoy very close ties with the independently run Longleaze Pre-school which is also on-site.

Royal Wootton Bassett is a small market town with a population of c 12,000. Situated in the north of the county, it lies 6 miles (9.5km) to the southwest of the major town of Swindon which is reached by the A3102. The town is located just two miles from Junction 16 of the M4 motorway connecting London with South Wales, allowing easy access to other towns and cities of the M4 corridor.
