queen

past

Science – Materials

materials

Materials are what objects are made from.

object

Something that can be seen or touched.

hard

Something that cannot change shape when you hold it.

soft

Something that can be squeezed or moulded.

shiny

An object with a bright, glowing surface.

stretchy

Able to be stretched when pulled.

dull

A surface that is not shiny.

rough

A bumpy surface – it is not smooth.
