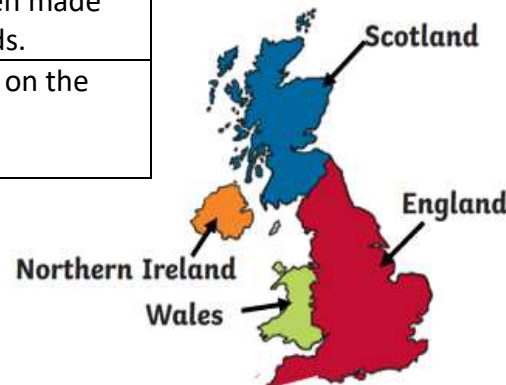
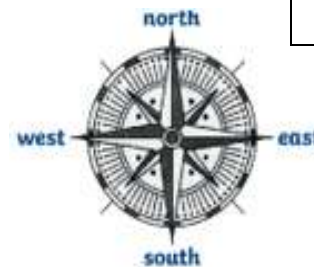

London, Belfast, Edinburgh, Cardiff	The capital cities of each country in the United Kingdom.
