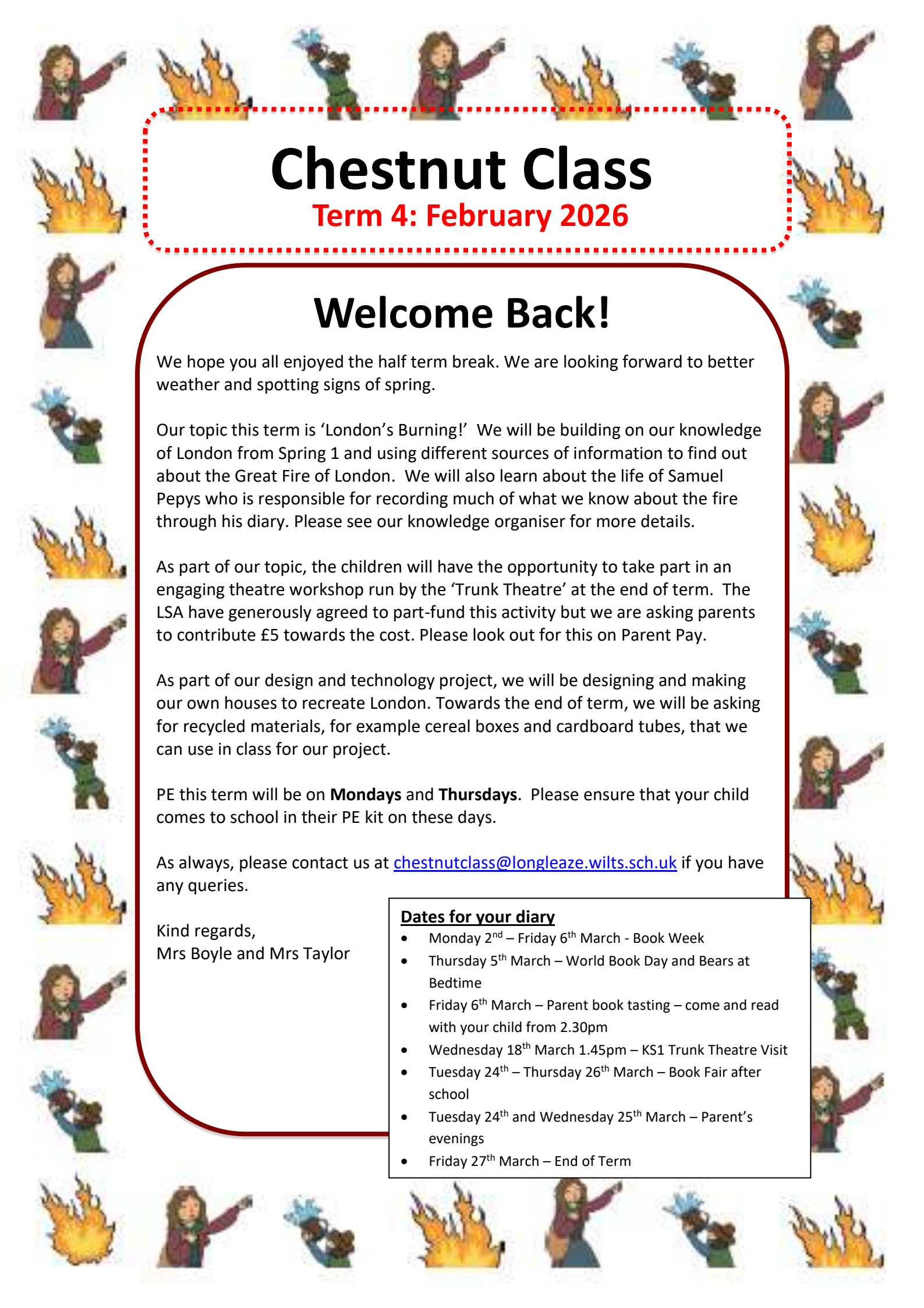




Chestnut Class
