4. Countries closer to the equator are warmer than those that are further away.

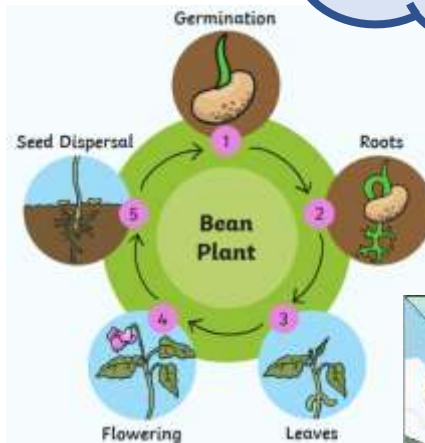


Plants

Science focus – plants

bulb	The underground stem and food storage which some plants grow from.
seed	A small, round object that is produced from a plant. When it is planted, a new plant can grow.
germination	The process of a seed starting to grow with shoots and roots.
shoot	A shoot grows upwards from the seed or bulb to find sunlight.
seed dispersal	When the seeds move away from the parent plant. They can drop to the ground in the plant's fruit or be moved by the wind or animals.
nutrition	Food or nourishment. Plants make their own food in their leaves using the sunlight.

country	An area of land which is controlled by a single government.
continent	A large solid area of land on Earth. These include Asia, Europe, Africa, North America, South America, Antarctica and Oceania.
oceans	The salt water between continents.
equator	An imaginary line around the middle of the globe that is halfway between the north and south poles.
human feature	Things that have been made by humans, e.g. roads.
physical feature	The natural features on the Earth's surface, e.g. mountains.
