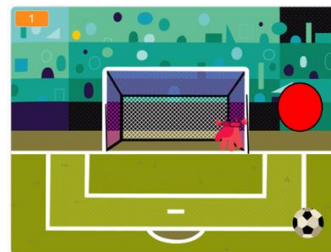
PE
